

MUSEUM CLEANING AND SAFETY GUIDELINES

Visitor Guidelines

- Face masks or coverings are optional. Masks are available at the Guest Services desk for those who wish to wear one.
- Guests should make reasonable efforts to maintain a distance of at least 6ft away from someone who is not in their party.

Museum Guidelines

- Maintain single-direction visitor flow when possible.
- Seating in meeting rooms and theater to follow social distancing guidelines.
- Social distancing in lobby must be observed and encouraged unless those are with the group guests came in with.
- Online admission ticket pre-payment is encouraged.

Cleaning Guidelines

- “High touch” areas such as door handles, push plates, railings, switches, touchscreens, and countertops shall be cleaned frequently throughout the day, depending on visitor volume.
- There will be regular cleaning of all areas that do not contain collections at the end of each work day.
- All POS equipment must be cleaned before and after a shift. If possible, there should only be one employee per POS station during a shift.
- Gift shop surfaces are disinfected regularly throughout the day, depending on visitor volume.
- Restrooms are disinfected regularly throughout the day, depending on visitor volume.
- Meeting Rooms are disinfected after use.

Sneeze Guards

- Ceiling hung sneeze guards are installed over each POS.

Signage and Floor Spacing Stickers

- Signs reminding employees and guests of proper handwashing and social distancing protocol will be spread throughout the museum.

Alcohol Wipes (for electronics)

- These are located in guest services desk area, under sink in break room, and in Research Room office area.
